**Warranty on their Home Appliances**  
**Important! Product Warranty Card – Please Retain**

**A TWO YEAR WARRANTY** (from date of purchase) for **Domestic Appliances used in Domestic Applications**. This includes both parts and labour to correct defects in materials or workmanship in the first 12 months and parts only in the second 12 months.

**Ninety Day Warranty** (from date of purchase) for **Domestic Appliances used in Commercial or Multi-Family Applications** that includes both parts and labour to correct defects in materials or workmanship.

**Microwave Ovens (excluding Built-in models):** This warranty does not cover in-home service.

**NB: For Built-in models,** in-home service is included.

**This Warranty does not cover the cost of:**

- A. Installation and delivery fees or correcting the installation of your appliance, instruction on the use of your appliance, connection/disconnection of house fuses or correct wiring or plumbing.
- B. Damage to appliance(s) caused by accident, misuse, fire, water damage or rust caused by abrasion, scratching or other physical damage. Note - Internal or External cabinet transport damage must be reported within 7 days of delivery date.
- C. Service where, travel time, freight or transport of goods requiring service from areas outside of those, which are serviced by Whirlpool or it's appointed Service partners.
- D. Damage/Repairs, resulting from repair work carried out by other than Authorised Whirlpool Services personnel or from the use of other than genuine Whirlpool Spare Parts or from the use of the appliance in a manner other than the use for which it was specifically designed.
- E. Damage caused by vermin, insects or pets.
- F. Failure to maintain the product as per the Use and Care Guide or Instruction Manual.
- G. Food loss or spoilage as a result of power or product failure.
- H. Internal or External damage as a result of excessive use of cleaning products or cleaning agents.
- I. Damage caused by power outages, electrical power surge or improper supply voltage via connection to Supply Authority mains or alternative supply systems.
- J. Damage or blockages caused by foreign objects e.g.: coins, underwires, nails, buttons or jewellery.
- K. Any consequential loss due to appliance failure.
- L. Light bulbs, removable wire, glass and plastic trays and other accessories.
- M. Repairs to parts or systems caused by unauthorised modifications made to appliance.
- N. Problems caused by incorrect or inadequate venting of the appliance.
- O. A service call out fee where no fault is found with the appliance.

The benefits conferred by this express warranty are in addition to all other conditions, warranties, guarantees, rights and remedies expressed or implied by the Trade Practices Act, the New Zealand Sale of Goods Act and similar State or Territory laws and all other obligations and liabilities on the part of the manufacturer or supplier and nothing contained herein shall restrict or modify such rights, remedies, obligations or liabilities.
